



Pardo Yachts is excited to unveil its latest flagship, the Pardo GT75, which will join the Pardo GT52 in the brand's expanding range. Measuring nearly 23 meters, the GT75 enhances the distinctive features of the GT series, combining high performance with luxurious comfort. Positioned between the Walkaround and Endurance ranges, the GT75 offers expansive interior volumes alongside the sleek, high-performance hull lines typical of a 75-foot yacht. The result is an elegant and versatile yacht that creates a perfect balance between comfort and style, offering an exceptional on-water experience.

The interior of the Pardo GT75 is designed to evoke the feeling of a floating villa. Every space, from the living areas to the accommodation, is thoughtfully crafted to optimise comfort and functionality. Large windows flood the interior with natural light, enhancing the sense of space and creating an inviting atmosphere. The GT75 is a true "crossover" yacht, offering flexibility in layout that caters to each owner's preferences. Building on the success of the Pardo GT52, which offers both galley-up and galley-down configurations, the GT75 offers even more customisation options, both inside and out. The main deck features several opening sections—such as the aft door, semi-open roof, sliding side doors, and side windows—that allow for a seamless flow between the interior and exterior spaces, ensuring constant communication with the sea.

The yacht's propulsion is powered by Volvo Penta IPS engines, with four options available, ranging from 3 x D13 IPS 900 to 3 x D13 IPS 1350, delivering up to 3000hp. This engine selection ensures excellent fuel efficiency and cruising comfort, key elements in Pardo Yachts' design philosophy. Additionally, the engine room is prepared for a future hybrid upgrade, further reducing environmental impact.

The GT75's deep-V hull is a product of Pardo Yachts' advanced technologies and 50 years of experience in the boating industry, including expertise from the sailing world. This hull design ensures both safety and comfort at sea, with a strong emphasis on sustainability, aiming to create harmony with the environment.

Versatility continues in the GT75's aft area, where two configurations are available: the "Tender Garage" and "Beach" versions. The Tender Garage version features a large sundeck and a cockpit that transforms to reveal a dedicated tender garage, offering a practical and luxurious solution for stowing the tender. The "Beach" version offers a spacious aft terrace with private access to the owner's cabin. This suite is designed with meticulous attention to detail, providing unparalleled views and a serene retreat. The Beach version's aft deck is flexible, allowing owners to set up freestanding furniture to suit their needs, whether for daytime relaxation or evening entertainment. Both versions can also include fold-down side terraces, which further expand the living space.

The walkaround design of the GT75 ensures a flush foredeck with generous lounging space. The bow area features a C-shaped sofa and table, complemented by a large sundeck, providing an inviting area for relaxation. This layout also maximises the interior volumes, especially in the forward section, which accommodates the VIP cabin and crew quarters.

The main deck offers two interior configurations: a galley-up version with an L-shaped dining area and a galley-down version that creates a more private, expansive living area. The galley-up layout opens directly onto the outdoor dining area, providing a seamless connection between interior and exterior spaces. In the galley-down version, the main deck features a spacious living area, while the well-equipped galley is located below deck amidships, allowing for year-round enjoyment of the yacht.

Below deck, the GT75 offers several cabin configurations to suit the owner's needs. The "Beach" version provides a private entrance to the master cabin from the aft platform, creating a luxurious and exclusive retreat. In the "Tender Garage" version, the master cabin is accessed via an interior staircase. The lower deck can accommodate up to 10 guests in two, three, or four cabins, plus crew accommodation. The standard layout features three cabins and three bathrooms, with careful attention to space optimisation, creating a layout worthy of larger vessels.





The Pardo GT75 is designed for owners who value luxury, exclusivity, and a deep connection with the sea. It combines high-performance capabilities with an extraordinary level of comfort and customisation. To further expand the range, Pardo Yachts is also preparing a T-Top version of the GT75, which will feature a completely open layout, further evolving the Walkaround series for those seeking more exposure to the elements and an even more versatile experience.
