Objectified

Marine Magnificence

Introduced in 2017, the original Pardo 43 quickly became a benchmark in the luxury walkaround segment. With more than 300 boats sold since, it has little need for reinvention. Instead, the latest iteration refines the model that built its reputation on clean lines, everyday usability, and assured performance.

For the first time, the interiors are done by Nauta Design, while the exterior is the result of a collaboration between Nauta Design and Zuccheri Yacht Design, with Zuccheri also responsible for naval architecture. The result is a considered evolution that sharpens the yacht's presence without disturbing its familiar silhouette. New hull windows introduce natural light below deck, while updated sunpads, a redesigned T-top, a reworked outdoor galley, and modular interiors that transition smoothly from day to night enhance life on board.

Practical upgrades are equally measured. The helm has been redesigned around a Garmin-developed yacht automation interface, and owners can specify optional stabilisers, high-speed Starlink connectivity, and increased fuel and freshwater capacities of 1,300 litres and 400 litres, respectively, for extended cruising. Propulsion is now tailored to preference, with a choice of Volvo Penta IPS 500, 600, or 650 drives, or a triple Mercury outboard configuration.
